It is my pleasure to invite Member States of the Intergovernmental Oceanographic Commission (IOC) of UNESCO and the organizations cooperating with and contributing to the work of the Commission to attend the Twenty-seventh Session of the Assembly of the IOC of UNESCO at UNESCO Headquarters, 7 Place de Fontenoy, 75007 Paris. The Assembly session will open on Wednesday 26 June 2013 at 10.00 in Conference Room II and should conclude its work on Friday 5 July 2013 at 13.00. The Assembly will be preceded by a one-day session of the Executive Council acting as the steering committee of the Assembly in Conference Room IV at UNESCO Headquarters.

A few other meetings are being scheduled on Monday 24 June in conjunction with the session as indicated in the Provisional Timetable attached, e.g. IOC Regional Subsidiary Body meeting under the chairmanship of Vice-chair Professor Adoté Blim Blivi and a meeting of the Intersessional Financial Advisory Group under the chairmanship of Vice-chair Professor Peter M. Haugan. The information about those meetings will be communicated at a later date and will be posted on the IOC website (Meeting calendar). The session will have a strong focus on the strategic developments for the Commission underlined by the development of the IOC Medium-term Strategy for 2014–2021 and IOC Programme and Budget for 2014–2017 (C/5), introducing a change in the programming and budgeting cycles. The session has a very tight agenda prepared by the Secretariat in accordance with Rule 8 of the IOC Procedure. The agenda will initiate discussions on the way that the Commission should be structured and how it should be best integrated in the oceanographic community and the international programmes to pursue its mission. Debates will also focus on resources and the commitments of its Member States to the IOC mission, its programmes and its projects.

Being fully aware of the significance of this Assembly session, the Director-General of UNESCO has granted emergency funds to allow the session to meet with the service of full interpretation during the plenary sessions with the exception of two half days, i.e. Friday 28 June a.m. and Wednesday 3 July a.m. In order to complete the funding of the Assembly, the IOC Officers strongly encourage IOC Member States to financially contribute to additional interpretation services, in particular during meetings of the Financial Committee, and to sponsorships of the IOC memorial lectures and social events.

During the last Executive Council, decisions were adopted immediately after an agenda item was discussed, a new system of reporting was used and the session was paperless. The measures resulted in substantial savings in time and cost. It is proposed to use the same method during the coming Assembly taking into account the comments made by the delegates at the end of the session last year. An information document on the working arrangements will be prepared. The documentation will consist primarily of an annotated agenda containing draft decisions and the text proposed for inclusion into the draft report. By Decision EC-XLV/Dec.5.3, the Executive Council at its 45<sup>th</sup> Session decided to use the Seventh Draft Guidelines for the Preparation and Consideration of Draft Resolutions on an experimental basis during this session of the Assembly. Under the draft guidelines, proposed text of draft resolutions should be submitted in writing to the Executive Secretary one month in advance and no later than 24 hours before the opening of the session of the Governing Body during which it will be considered for adoption. There will be an exception for the resolutions on the IOC Medium-term Strategy and the C/5. The Draft Resolutions received will be posted on the Assembly website for information of IOC Member States before their formal review by the Resolutions Committee.

<u>Supplementary items</u>: As stipulated by Rule of Procedure No. 9, *supplementary items requiring a decision* may be submitted to the Secretariat by any Member State of the Commission or partner organizations **not later than two months before the beginning of the session, i.e. 26 April 2013**. Member States/partner organizations requesting the inclusion of a supplementary item should at the same time submit to the Secretariat a short working document composed of a brief background, the action requested from the Assembly and the financial implication if any. To ensure smooth management and timely circulation of such supplementary documentation to all Member States in the working languages of the Commission, the Secretariat can only handle documents not longer than two pages (800 words). I remind you that English, French, Russian and Spanish are the working languages of the Commission.

<u>Elections</u>: The elections of the officers of the Commission and the members of the Executive Council will take place during this session of the Assembly in accordance with the technical arrangements appended to the IOC Rules of Procedure (IOC/INF-1166). For easy reference the relevant information and forms and an updated list of geographical groups and distribution of seats on the Executive Council will be available on the Assembly website. **Candidatures must reach the IOC Secretariat at latest two working days before the day of the elections.** 

<u>Registration and notification of delegations</u>: Registration for the Session will take place from 08.00 on Monday 24 June, at the main entrance of UNESCO Headquarters (7 Place de Fontenoy, 75007

Paris) for security clearance and delivery of badges. For security reasons and organizational purposes it is particularly important that IOC Members States and partner organizations notify the Secretariat of the names of their designated representatives, alternates and advisers for the session, using the attached form, which should be returned to the Secretariat by email not later than 25 May 2013 with copy to their Permanent Delegation to UNESCO. I remind you that the Executive Council recommended that a higher target of 25 % be set for participation of women in IOC activities in the period 2008–2013, and urged Member States to take gender equality into consideration when nominating participants in IOC activities and meetings.

French visa: If needed, formalities for visa applications should be started in your country at least one month before the planned date of arrival. If specifically requested, not later than a month in advance, the IOC Secretariat will send a letter to the French Consulate to support individual requests for obtaining a visa to attend the session. IOC Member States of the Executive Council will also find in attachment the provisional agenda for the session.

Before concluding I wish to inform you that the Director-General has decided to extend my appointment as Assistant Director-General of UNESCO and Executive Secretary of the IOC from November 2013 until 11 January 2015. As this decision has an impact on the recruitment process of the new IOC Executive Secretary, a new timeline for the process and complete documentation on the matter will be examined by the Executive Council at this session under item 5 of the provisional agenda.
