




Figure 1 Number of live rescues made by ISAR teams for each earthquake.

Type of event: unknown

Time of disaster: 00.58 GMT, X-mas night

scale of event: multinationation impact - 14 countries, two continent

An european emergency: thousand of EU citizens to be repatriated, several casualties

A three steps operations

1° step

In - EMT's /medicines/body disposal/DVI

Out - evacuation/repatriation

2° step

Tents

Wash

3° step

Rapid reconstruction
