

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Requests the IOCARIBE Secretary to coordinate with other UN agencies and regional initiatives to promote science -based sustainable marine economy practices through its Member States;

**Requests** the IOCARIBE Secretary, working with Member States and regional partners to build a common understanding on the appropriate science and services needed to support the decisionmaking for sustainable marine economy best practices within the context of the IOCARIBE Biennial Work Program and co-designed UN Decade of Ocean Science actions; and

**Encourages** the IOCARIBE Member States to collaborate in designing and implementing IOCARIBE programs to achieve SDG 14 which aims to "conserve and sustainably use the oceans, seas and marine resources for sustainable development".
