

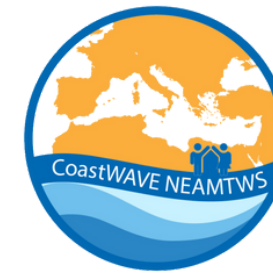

Background

At the ICG/NEAMTWS XVII session in November 2021, the Group noted of the concept note study prepared by the IOC ICG/NEATWS Secretariat on Coastal Multi-Hazard Risk Perception, Resilience and Survey Questionnaires to contribute to the implementation of the new European Union DG-ECHO project “CoastWAVE’ concerning understanding and communication of tsunami and other sea-level related risk.

- The ICG/NEAMTWS also tasked Working Group 4 and new Task Team on Tsunami Ready to examine the survey questionnaires.
- The survey activities currently being carried out falls under Component 1 of CoastWAVE project :

Activity 4: Develop concept note, identify target communities design survey protocol, socialise survey in target communities

Activity 5: Conduct the survey, Focus Group Discussions and other data collection activities and analyse the results

Activity 6: Prepare report, translate into Arabic and circulate to partner agencies, target communities and ICG/NEAMTWS WG4

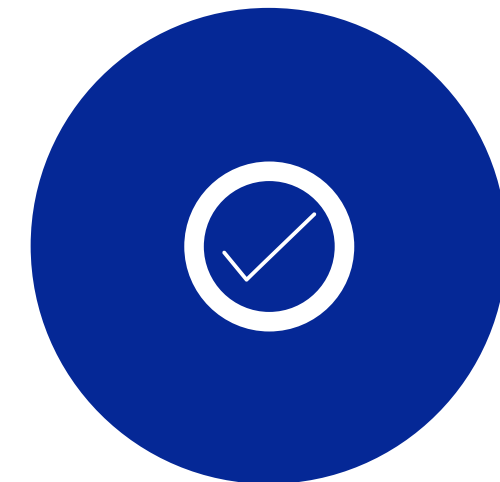
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
