Subject: Exercise Pacific Wave 2022 (PacWave22), including a live Tsunami Service Providers Communication Test on 13 October 2022: publication of the Exercise Manual and invitation to an Informational Webinar on 13 September 2022

With reference to IOC Circular Letter <u>2894</u> issued on the subject, at its 29th session (<u>ICG/PTWS-XXIX/3</u>, 1–2 and 7–8 December 2021), the Intergovernmental Coordination Group for the Pacific Tsunami Warning and Mitigation System approved the conduct of Exercise Pacific Wave 2022 (PacWave22) in the months of September through November 2022 to support <u>International Disaster</u> <u>Risk Reduction Day</u> (13 October) and <u>World Tsunami Awareness Day</u> (5 November). It was further decided that PacWave 22 will be conducted as a <u>series of regional exercises</u> organized through the PTWS Regional Working Groups where applicable, with support from the PTWS Tsunami Service Providers (TSPs) and the International Tsunami Information Center (ITIC), involving all PTWS countries, with <u>one live communications test</u> from PTWS TSPs to Member States on 13 October 2022. This circular letter supersedes IOC Circular Letter <u>2894</u> dated 23 June.

The PacWave Exercise Manual (<u>IOC Technical Series</u>, <u>175</u>, <u>Vol. 1</u>) attached herewith contains details and guidance, and the post-exercise evaluation questionnaire. All exercise documents, including information on regional exercises, will be posted at PacWave22 website <u>http://www.pacwave.info</u>.

The live test will occur at **0000 UTC on 13th October 2022**. Member States should note when and how they receive the live communications test message and report back through the PacWave22 Communications Test online Evaluation Form. The PacWave22 communications test evaluation form will be made available at https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/pacwave22_comm from 13 to 23 October 2022. **The form should be completed by <u>23rd October 2022</u> at the latest.**

In addition to the one live communication test and series of regional exercises, Member States may choose to conduct national exercises according to the PacWave22 objectives at any time between 1st September and 30th November 2022, allowing flexibility to avoid conflict with other important national events.

The PacWave22 Post-Exercise Evaluation Form for the regional and national exercises conducted at the initiative of Member States, will be available at <u>https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/pacwave22_eval</u>. The form should be completed by 21st December 2022 at the latest.

To answer questions related to PacWave22, ITIC and IOC will host an **PacWave22 informational webinar on 13 September 2022 at 0300 UTC in English, and 1800 UTC primarily in Spanish**. Information on the webinar, including the agenda and documents, and the connection details, are available from the meeting registration website: <u>https://oceanexpert.org/registerEvent/3622</u>. Connection links will also be sent to all PTWS TNCs and TWFPs via email.
