



5.5 Enhanced communication and engagement strategy to raise awareness of Ocean Decade activities

Current status of Decade implementation





- Low number of Decade Actions, especially in SIDS
- Limited availability of funding and resources for design, delivery and coordination of transformative ocean science in the region
- Few National Decade Committees and lack of regional coordinating framework for sharing of experiences and learning
- Lack of regional vision and ownership for Ocean Decade amongst diverse stakeholder groups
- Lack of tangible examples of approaches and impact of working across science policy society influence
