Ocean science concepts integrated into formal education curricula in order to enhance global ocean literacy



Dialogue enhanced and collaboration increased through the inclusion of diverse stakeholders in ocean literacy discussions



Products and ocean literacy resources should include accessibility access options



Capacity of stakeholders (e.g. governments, private sector, social sciences, indigenous communities, journalists, communities) to engage in ocean literacy discussions and activities strengthened
