## Results of the voting procedure

- (i) number of votes cast - 116 (same as announced after the vote)**
- (ii) number of non-valid ballot papers received - 2**
- (iii) number of valid votes cast -  $116 - 2 = 114$**
- (iv) majority needed by any candidate for election (next integer immediately above half the number of valid votes cast -  $57 + 1 = 58$ )**
- (v) a further ballot is not needed.**
