Subject: Hosting of the Pacific Islands – Global Ocean Observing System

Regional Alliance (PI-GOOS) Secretariat/Office

I have the great pleasure to inform you that the Secretariat of the Pacific Community (SPC) has been selected to host the Pacific Islands – Global Ocean Observing System (GOOS) Regional Alliance (PI-GOOS) Secretariat/Office.

IOC/GOOS Office received several strong applications in response to the call for Expressions of Interest to host the PI-GOOS Secretariat/Office (IOC CL-2922), which is an indication of the high level of interest across the Pacific Islands in advancing sustained ocean observations to address ocean management, coastal hazards warnings, and sustainable development for coastal and island communities. The PI-GOOS Regional Alliance will play a vital role in advancing the sustained ocean observing capacity of the region and ensuring that this fit-for-purpose system meets the needs of the Pacific Islands countries and is an integrated part of the global ocean observing system. Following a review process and selection of SPC as the host of the PI-GOOS Office for the PI-GOOS region, the GOOS Steering Committee (SC) accepted this decision in May of 2023.

As a first step, SPC proposes to rejuvenate PI-GOOS by installing a new governance structure composed of regional partners, re-establish the PI-GOOS coordinator role within SPC, and provide secretariat/office support to PI-GOOS. The new PI-GOOS governance will include a steering committee composed of regional organizations' representatives ensuring that PI-GOOS closely collaborates with the Pacific Islands Marine and Ocean Services Panel of the Pacific Meteorological Council, hosted at SPREP, which will increase the collaborative activities of IOC-UNESCO and WMO in the Pacific regions, and provide a venue for PI-GOOS to report to countries.
