ARRIVAL AT MEETING



HOTEL RESERVATION



LOCAL TRANSPORTATION


Participants shall arrange their local transportation between the airport and the hotel and between the hotel and the venue. The hotels listed below are within walking distance of the venue.

Some hotels can provide the shuttle between the airport and the hotel, and / or the hotel and the venue. Uber and similar e-hailing services are also available, as well as the <u>MyCiti Bus service</u>. A map showing their Sea Point route is shown below should your hotel be located further away from the Sea Point (a) as well as if you are travelling from the V&A Waterfront (b).

CURRENCY EXCHANGE

The local currency is the South African Rand. There are currency exchange offices at the Cape Town International Airport as well as most banks. Credit cards are also readily accepted at all hotels, shops and facilities. For updated exchange rates, please consult the <u>XE website</u>.

LOCAL CLIMATE IN SEPTEMBER

The mean weather conditions in Cape Town in September are as follows:

- September in Cape Town marks the onset of Spring.
- Average daytime temperatures range from 13 °C to 20 °C (55 °F to 68 °F)
- During the day, the weather is often mild and pleasant, suitable for outdoor activities and sightseeing. However, evenings and early mornings tend to be cooler, so you should consider packing layered clothing to accommodate the temperature drop.

FUN THINGS TO DO IN AND AROUND CAPE TOWN

- <u>Mojo Market (Lifestyle & food market)</u> about 15 mins walk from workshop venue.
- <u>Iziko</u> and other South African Museums about 15 mins drive from workshop venue (in Cape Town city centre).
- <u>Zeitz MOCAA Museum</u> about 15 mins drive from workshop venue (located in the waterfront).
- <u>Table mountain aerial cable car</u> about 15 mins drive from workshop venue.
- Two Oceans Aquarium about 15 mins drive from workshop venue (located in the waterfront).


INTERNET ACCESS AND COMMUNICATIONS

Wireless internet connectivity will be freely available to the participants, at the meeting's venue.

The Local Organizing Committee can facilitate participants to purchase local SIM cards for mobile phones, if required. This service should also be available on arrival at the Cape Town International Airport.

ELECTRICITY VOLTAGE

The voltage in South Africa is 220-240 Volts. Primary socket types in South Africa use the type D and M Plugs (see image below). At the venue, there will be extension leads and multiplugs available. Some of these are fitted with the standard two-prong (European) plug type, but please consider purchasing an adaptor for visiting South Africa. If you have a European plug it is easy to purchase an additional local adaptor within SA if needed. These should also be available at electronics shops on arrival at Cape Town International Airport.
