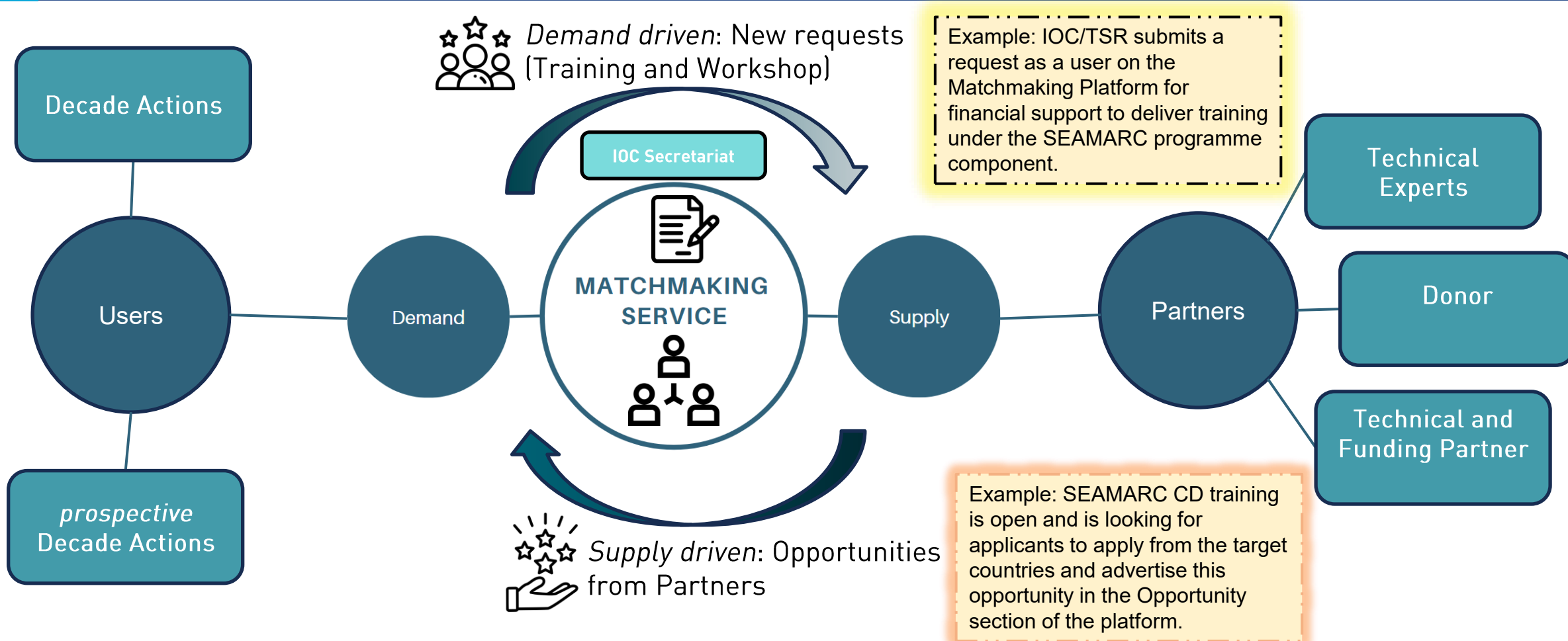

Mechanism behind Matchmaking Platform



Matchmaking – Request Section

1.

Submit new Request

Use this feature to submit a new capacity development request for training and workshops

2.

List of My Requests

Use this feature to track the progress and current status of your submitted request.

1.

For institutions to submit a request for in-kind, financial, or technical *support to deliver* a training or workshop. Each request includes 27 required questions to complete.

2.

For institutions to track the status of their request, continue working on drafts, review offers, and upload supporting documents once the activity enters implementation.

3.

For partner institutions to preview all the validated requests to decide whether they want to express interest.

4.

For partners to manage their matched requests after a match, including reviewing the finalized offer, accessing the validated application, and uploading documents through the project lifecycle.
