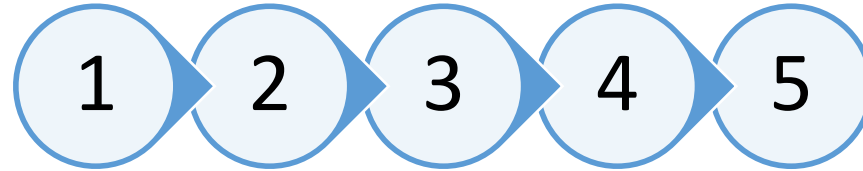
It's all about a success story

*Consider the criteria for selecting the community to decide which level of Tsunami Ready should be implemented*

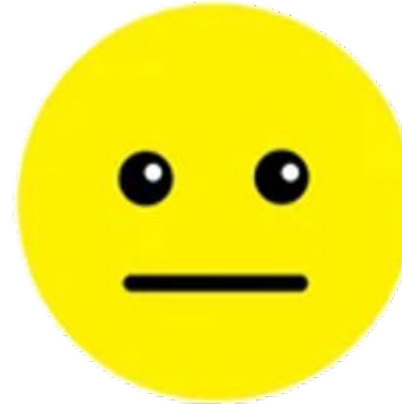
# Q1: Is this community aware of the tsunami hazard in their area?



**They have good awareness and preparedness regarding the tsunami hazard.**



**They have awareness and preparedness for other hazards, but not for the tsunami.**

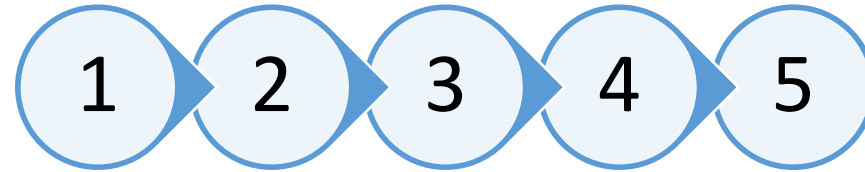


**They are aware of the tsunami hazard but are not prepared for it.**



**They do not have any awareness or preparedness for the tsunami hazard.**

# Q2: Have there been any specific awareness and preparedness activities in this community?



**There are regular community activities on tsunami awareness and preparedness (at least once a year)**



**There are regular awareness and preparedness activities for other hazards, but not for the tsunami (at least once a year)**

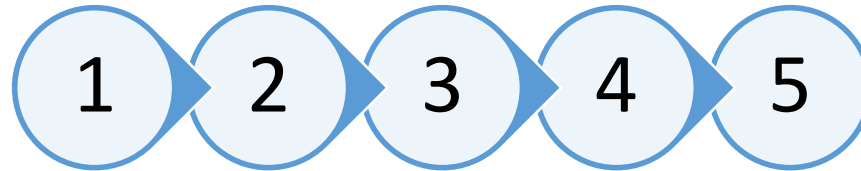


**There were activities, but not in the past few years**



**There have not been any awareness or preparedness activities**

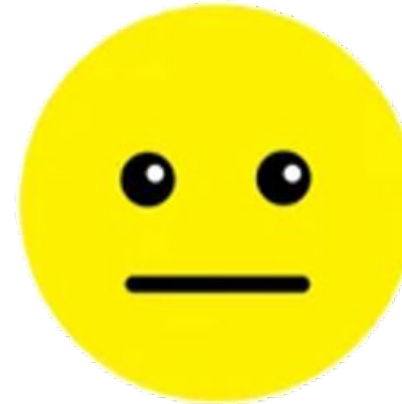
# Q3: Are there programs in place to conduct disaster awareness and preparedness in the community?



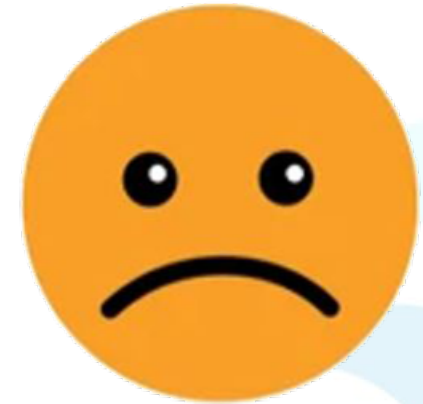
**There is a specific program for tsunami awareness and preparedness**



**There is a program for multi-hazards, including tsunami**



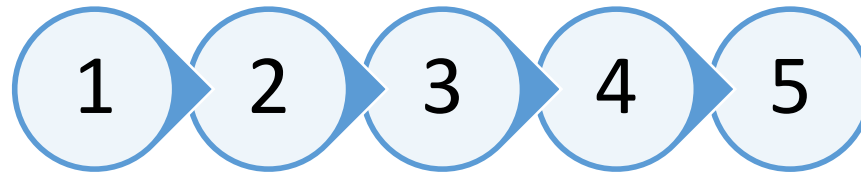
**There is a program, but it is for other hazards not for tsunami**

# Q4: Are there any community champions who can be engaged for disaster risk reduction?



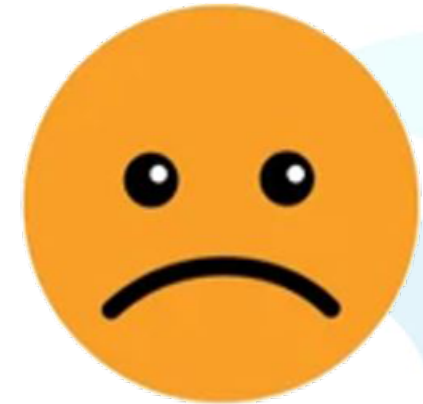
**Yes, there are several champions who have been actively engaged**



**There are champions, but they have never been engaged**

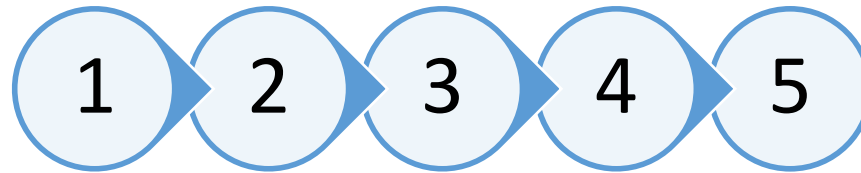


**There might be champions, but they still need to be identified**



**There are no champions that can be engaged**

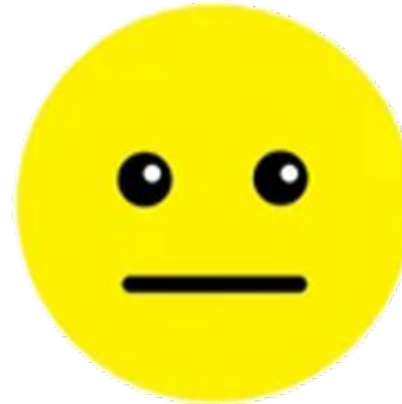
# Q5: Will the community be enthusiastic about building tsunami awareness and preparedness?
