




RESULTS OF THE SURVEY II.4. TSUNAMI READY RECOGNITION PROGRAMME



UNESCO-IOC TRRP (1/6)

INVOLVEMENT OF THE COUNTRIES IN TRPP

14a) Does your country have an interest to participate in the UNESCO-IOC TRRP? Answered: 39 Skipped: 0

- OVERALL 59% (23 countries) participating in TRRP
- CENTRAL AMERICAN PACIFIC COAST 83%
- SOUTH CHINA SEA 50%
- SOUTHEAST PACIFIC 50%
- PACIFIC ISLAND COUNTRIES AND TERRITORIES 69%

INVOLVEMENT OF THE COUNTRIES IN TRPP

14a) Does your country have an interest to participate in the UNESCO-IOC TRRP? Answered: 39 Skipped: 0

- 8 countries (20,5%) have plans to do so Reasons for not having contributed yet:
 - o lack of human resources and funding
 - o on-going negotiation with relevant authorities
 - o process of determining how existing programmes would translate to TRRP and if they meet all aims
- 8 countries (20,5%) do not plan to implement TRPP Reasons:
 - existence of other programmes that do not require external certification
 - knowledge of coastal communities and possible misunderstanding encouraged by the implementation of a new programme
 - lack of knowledge on the subject
 - evaluation according to the Tsunami Ready Equivalency Guidance discussed by the ICG/PTWS both effective and efficient

INVOLVEMENT OF THE COUNTRIES IN OTHER INITIATIVES

14b) Aside from UNESCO-IOC TRRP, is your country currently implementing any other tsunami resilience and preparedness related initiatives or programmes?

Answered: 39 Skipped: 0

- 19 countries (49%) implementing other initiatives and programmes:
 - o running local / national programmes (e.g. DESTANA, TOWER project, COAST project), national multi-hazard programmes, and international programmes (e.g. Tsunami Safe School Programme)
 - participating in the World Tsunami Awareness Day
 - o conducting earthquake and tsunami exercises in schools and performing tabletop exercises
 - o training on community-based disaster risk management with a multi-hazard approach
 - improving facilities for tsunami disaster prevention
 - o conducting public education, preparedness and awareness activities
 - mapping out evacuation center

14c) What number of villages, cities/districts and provinces/state levels in your country are at risk to tsunami? Answered: 39 Skipped: 0

Estimation of 458,369 villages – 2,799 cities/districts - 324 provinces/states

14d) Does your country have a National Tsunami Ready Board (NTRB)? Answered: 39 Skipped: 0

- 13 countries with a NTRB (33%)
- 16 countries with an existing coordination mechanism that could fulfil this role, consisting of National Councils and Advisory Groups

INSTITUTION NEEDING TO BE INVOLVED

14e) Which institution(s) should be involved in the implementation of TRRP or similar national initiative? Answered: 36 Skipped: 3

From individual institutions (e.g. NDMO, NTWC), to a variety of national agencies, coastal councils, local and
provincial governments, ministries, police, army forces and emergency services, academics, civil societies, and nongovernmental organisations (e.g. Red Cross)

IMPLEMENTATION

14f) Are any communities (for example, villages, cities, districts, provinces, or states) in your country currently working towards implementing or interested in implementing the UNESCO-IOC TRRP or similar national initiative? Answered: 37 Skipped: 2

- For 22 countries (59%): communities currently working towards implementing UNESCO-IOC or interested to do 14g) Have any communities in your country achieved recognition through UNESCO-IOC TRRP or similar national initiative? Answered: 38 Skipped: 1
- For 13 countries (34%): completion of TRPP or similar initiatives



NATIONAL CAPACITY TO IMPLEMENT INDICATORS

Questions 15a) to 15l)

Answered: 39 Skipped: 0 (except for question 15b Answered: 33 Skipped: 6)



- Between 74% and 92% of the countries have the national capacity for implementing indicators totally or partially
- ≥90% are very much able to achieve entirely or partially 5 aspects relying on their national capacity and some international technical expertise
- Between 11% and 26% need technical support from ITIC and/or ICG/PTWS activities for 7 aspects




